Fourteen contestants vied for top spots in three categories in the TAOM competition in 2016 in Corpus Christi. Every one of the seven senior close-up competitors presented an act filled with talent and skill, as did the three junior stage and four senior stage entries. The judges were very pleased with the consistently high scores.

For the first time in TAOM history, adult contest winners received cash awards in addition to the prestigious Willard the Wizard Trophy. Junior contest winners have, for several years, received cash awards from donations made for that purpose by the Royal and Carol Brin Trust and the late Don Stiefel. This year, senior contest winners received \$685 each from donations made by

the Houston Association of Magicians, Houston IBM Ring 39, Houston SAM Assembly 19, the Fort Worth Magicians Club and generous magicians who contributed to a GoFundMe account set up for that purpose by David Hira.

Congratulations to every one of the contestants for their dedication to the art of magic and their willingness to share their talents.




