

## **MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT**

Well, we're heading into spring already. And when April 4th hits, the price for the TAOM goes up one more time. Our annual convention is going to be in Frisco this year and it is the first one put on by the TAOM itself, not by a local club, so we will be needing your help over Labor Day weekend (September 1-4) to make this one great.

I had thought about playing like Magic LIVE and not saying who the acts were gonna be, but then Stan decided to have a Magic LIVE this year in addition to the IBM-SAM combined convention and then Genii's convention, so I figured I had to talk about who was gonna be at our convention.

You can go to <u>http://www.taom.org/assoc/2017-convention-registration/</u> to sign up. And we've worked very hard to keep the price down. Until April 4th it costs \$190 for adults and \$135 for students.

When you combine that with our hotel for \$119 a night for a 2-room suite that can sleep up to 4 easily and comes with a microwave and refrigerator, a full breakfast every morning and a cocktail reception every night, we are one of the most affordable conventions in the country.

One of the things that we are trying to do is come up with new faces and acts for the TAOM. We don't want to hear the complaint that it is the same old stuff. *It won't be!* 

I am using some elements of Magic LIVE in that there will be plenty of lectures and fun stuff. Already I told you about **Bizzaro** and **Christian and Katalina** as our acts, neither act had ever been booked for a TAOM before. This time I am going to reveal another performer. This guy is one of the most creative minds in magic. The thing is, he so busy doing corporate work (which obviously pays a lot more than conventions) that he rarely performs at a magic convention. I mean very rarely. **But we have him.** 

**Gregory Wilson** will be featured for the first time at the TAOM. Gregory will be seen both on stage, in close-up and he will be lecturing. A triple threat. Actually, quadruple because Gregory also will be in our dealer room. He has been traveling the country a bit with Penguin dealing and lecturing at their Magic EXPOs. He has some terrific effects including his Rubik's cube.

We're also working on something special for one of the evenings, but I'll write about that later. The hint is **Gregory and Bizzaro working together**...and it may have been a TV show.
