You may have seen **Shimshi** on Wizard Wars or maybe on America's Got Talent where he was the last magician standing in 2008. Before Wynn asked him to make the Wynn his home, he spent two years at the Mirage, then when to the Sahara in the World's Greatest Magic Show and at the V variety show at Planet Hollywood. W. David Luther January 28, 2942 - May 26, 2017

Rest in peace, Dear Friend. David died after a lengthy illness, but will be remembered as a genuinely good person. He served as Legal Advisor for the Texas Association of Magicians for many years and was president of the organization in 19.. for the annual TAOM convention in Austin.

David was a true renaissance man -- real estate attorney, licensed pilot, MENSA member, certified scuba driver, law enforcement finger print expert, professional photographer, EMS volunteer besides his avocation as magician, mentalist, and balloon sculptor.

A Life Member of the Society of American Magicians, David helped revitalize Assembly 206, bringing the Austin assembly into national prominence. Starting in 1990, David organized and produced a series of several dozen workbooks for assembly meetings, and headed up a National Magic Week celebration that was judged the best in the nation.

David created his own kind of magic with the people he knew, and will be missed.

John Ice June 8, 1934 - May 15, 2017

John William Ice passed peacefully in Houston following a long battle with dementia.

John served in the U.S. Army during the Korean War. He had a long, successful career in the printing business in both Chicago and Houston. He was a lifelong member of the International Brotherhood of Magicians, the Society of American Magicians and the Texas Association of Magicians and served as President of the Houston magic clubs.



John will be remembered fondly for his dry sense of humor, soft-spoken kindness, and sleight- of-hand at the magic table.



PAUL DIAMOND July 21, 1928 - May 7, 2017

Alas to say, "Mr. Humble" is with us no more. Magician, magic dealer, and lecturer Paul Diamond's light and fire have faded, dimmed, and died.

Paul was a Life Member of the International Brotherhood of Magicians with the Order of Merlin Excalibur (50 years of continuous service). His Texas Association of Magicians membership goes back to 1965. His dealers' booth at TAOM conventions was always a lively gathering spot. For many years, he and his wife Andi owned and operated Paul's Magic and Fun Shop in Fort Lauderdale.

His self-applied title, "Mr. Humble", was an amusing contrast to his boisterous manner and bombastic wit.



The passing of dear friends and colleagues saddens the heart but makes one realize how precious those friendships are. TAOM conventions are the glue that binds you to magicians who live far away. This annual get-together is important in so many ways. Please come this year and bring a young magician to foster the next generation for magic. I'll see you there.
