Members also discussed the need for a small correction to the bylaws. A change in the wording of contest rules will be mailed to Board members for notification before the next Board meeting. Another issue brought before the group was the possibility of member clubs sponsoring, in whole or in part, convention registration for an up-and-coming young magician and his/her family from their city.



Magician, creator, inventor, innovator, author, and all-around good guy John Cornelius has passed. He entered the world on April 22, 1048 and left us on April 21, 2019. Among the numerous awards garnered by this magic genius was the

first place in close-up at the 1979 FISM. His illustrious career in magic is applauded world-wide. Hardly a magician any where doesn't "do" one of John's creations or routines.

John is survived by this wife LInda. A Rosary will be held at our Lady of Sorrows Church, 3107 N. St. Mary's, on Thursday, April 25. On Friday there will be a service at 10:30 a.m. at Lady of Sorrows Church with a procession following to San Fernando #3 for internment.
