Message from the President


Another month, another performer! We're happy to announce the addition of Lucio Martinez to the stellar line-up of stage performers for this year's convention. See details below.

He competed at IBM in the stage magic competition in Jacksonville in 2015 and in San Antonio in 2016. In 2018, he won first place and the People's Choice Award at the Winter Carnival of Magic in Tennessee and was invited to perform there in 2019.

FAREWELL, JOHN CORNELIUS




